

Research Ecologist or Research Forester

The Forest and Rangeland Ecosystem Science Center (FRESC) is seeking applications for a permanent full-time position as a Research Ecologist or a Research Forester. FRESC is a component of the Biological Resources Division of the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, OR. The primary duties will include: (a) integrating existing research and coordinating future research conducted under the Cooperative Forest Ecosystem Research project; (b) addressing research needs of resource management agencies; and (c) developing a complex research program to address a multiple set of topics such as reforestation, effects of fire, tree harvest, and other disturbances of forest community development. The incumbent must have a Ph.D. in forestry, natural resources, or botany with a specialization in forest ecology. The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate a history of the ability to propose, fund, conduct, and publish research in forest ecology. Salary ranges from \$51,927 to \$89,279 per year and benefits include health and life insurance coverage, flexible work schedules, Employee Assistance Program, vacation and sick leave, and Family-Friendly Leave policies.
