### Assistant Professor, Wildlife Science

Twelve-month, tenure track position in wildlife science. Appointment is 40% College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, and 60% Tennessee Agricultural Experiment Station.

Job Description: Incumbent will teach two upper division wildlife courses annually, plus a graduate course in area of expertise in alternate years, advise undergraduate and graduate students, and participate in the academic affairs of department, college, and university as needed. Incumbent will develop a research program in wildlife, with emphasis on ecology and management of wetland wildlife and associate habitats on public and private lands. She/he will actively seek extramural funds and grants. She/he will utilize suitable Tennessee Experiment Station lands and resources for wildlife research projects, publish in professional journals and present research findings at conferences. She/he will participate in the programs of the department and university as needed.

Qualifications: Ph.D in wildlife science or related field. Professional record of teaching and research in wildlife science preferred. Women and minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
